Emergency assistance to defenders in immediate danger **Individual protection**


Tailored assistance focused on the protection needs of an individual defender

Geographical distribution of the **Human Rights Defenders (HRDs)** supported in 2022

KEY NUMBERS IN 2022

Agir ensemble assisted 172 HRDs at risk (16% of those belonged to a minority group) in 16 countries around the world

Assistance to HRDs amounted to 324 295,56 €

Agir Ensemble put in place 6 projects for the protection of **HRDs**

The majority of HRDs supported by Agir ensemble received threats by legal authorities
